In our search throughout 2012 for an existing quartet, or separate players wishing to form a new quartet, 25 participants of the highest standard in the country participated in auditions at the RIAM in November 2012.

Strings Attached: A Mentoring Programme offers young string quartets a unique opportunity to nurture potential, in the professional environment of the Royal Irish Academy of Music, working alongside the internationally acclaimed Vogler Quartet.

Now in its second year we are delighted to have the Chiral Quartet return to the festival this year and they will be joined by the Arioso Quartet from the RIAM. Both quartets have worked with Tim Vogler since September 2013. Also, as part of **Strings Attached**, Hugh Murray from the Chiral Quartet, was invited by Frank Reinecke, to study in the Felix Mendelssohn Bartholdy, *Hochschule für Musik und Theater*, Leipzig, from September 2013 - June 2014.

Strings attached has transformed string quartets in the Royal Irish Academy of Music. In the short two years since its inception, we have produced over ten quartets from age 10 up to Masters level. At all ages and stages the Vogler Quartet have guided our students, in partnership with RIAM faculty, towards a greater understanding of the demands and rewards of playing in a string quartet.
