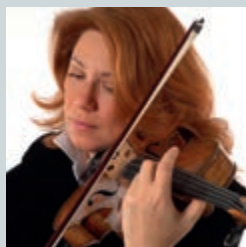

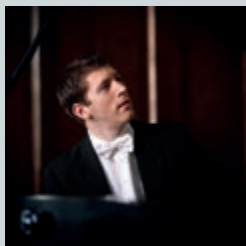

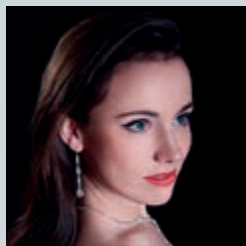

Music in Drumcliffe continues Strings Attached Mentoring & Masterclass Programme

A Music Education Programme for Advanced Young String Quartets and Students of Music.

Since 2012 **Strings Attached** has offered young string quartets a unique opportunity to nurture potential, in the professional environment of the Royal Irish Academy of Music, working alongside the internationally acclaimed Vogler Quartet. This programme continues throughout the academic year with regular visits by Tim Vogler and the Vogler Quartet to the RIAM to work with 10 String Quartets.

Now in its third year we take an extra step as Music in Drumclife and the RIAM partner with Music Generation Sligo to offer Masterclasses with the Vogler Quartet and a number of festival guest artists during the festival weekend.

Masterclasses are available for advanced students (Grade 7+) under the age of 18 in violin, viola, cello, piano and for string quartets - see schedule below. Early booking is advised as places are limited. The masterclasses will take place at Yeats Country Hotel, Rosses Point, Sligo.

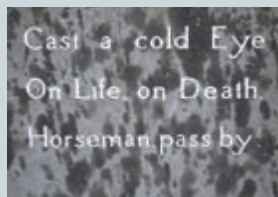
