Formed in East Berlin in 1985, the Vogler Quartet quickly established itself as one of the finest quartets of this generation, renowned for an extraordinary musical intelligence. creative playing, powerful interpretations and unconventional programming. In 1986 they came to international prominence through winning the International String Quartet Competition in Evian, with the press jury prize and a special prize for the best interpretation of a contemporary work. They were subsequently invited to study with the renowned La Salle Quartet in Basel, Switzerland and at the University of Cincinnati, U.S.A. In 1987 they took part in masterclasses with Arnold Steinhard (Guarneri Ouartet), and Sandor Vegh. György Kurtag continues to be an inspiration to the quartet. The Vogler Ouartet now combines an international schedule in all the major music centres with a busy teaching career which includes masterclasses and individual lessons.
